May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'I', received from the District Judge, Gonda, regarding submission of his opinion in connection with submission of information about purchase of new Maruti Swift Dzire Ldi car by Sri Ajay Vikram Singh, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gonda.

In this connection, it is submitted that earlier in the matter of submission of information about purchase of new Maruti Swift Dzire car by Sri Ajay Vikram Singh, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gonda, as submitted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.I. Murtaza through detailed office note dated 07.12.2009 (flagged 'II'), His Lordships has been pleased to pass order dated 11.12.2009 (flagged 'O'), calling the D.J. to send his opinion in the matter whether the officer can live befitting the status of a judicial officer within the amount that survives with him. The order was communicated to the District Judge, Gonda vide Court's letter dated 23.12.2009.

Now, in reply of the Court's letter dated 23.12.2009, the District Judge, Gonda, vide his letter dated 05.01.2010 at flag 'I' has submitted his opinion in the matter and has stated that as per report submitted by Sri Singh (flag 'M'), his total monthly salary is Rs. 22,990/- and after deduction of GIS of Rs. 120/- and after repaying EMI of Rs. 6,167/- against car loan, a sum of Rs. 16,703/- remains with him for his expenses. He has been married recently on 29.11.2009 and he has no child. His father is an Advocate and Income tax payee for about 33 years and his mother is posted as Professor in a Degree College earning about Rs. 70,000/- per month. He has also agricultural land from where he gets grains and agricultural income time to time, hence, the amount of Rs. 16,703/- is sufficient for managing the affairs befitting the status of a judicial officer. The District Judge, Gonda has, therefore, stated that according to his opinion, the remaining/ available sum of Rs. 16,703/- per month is sufficient for the officer to manage his family affairs, befitting the status of a judicial officer.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.I. Murtaza for His Lordship kind perusal and further orders in the matter?
