May kindly see the letter dated 17.09.2013 of Sri Shankar Prasad Srivastava, District & Sessions Judge, J.P. Nagar, regarding appearance of Sri Mohd. Quamar, the then Judicial Magistrate, J.P. Nagar now posted as Civil Judge, (Jr. Div.), Muzaffarnagar on 21.10.2013 for adducing evidence on 21.10.2013, in connection with case no. 7/2011 crime no.1444/2010 State versus Sumit under section 363, 366, 376 I.P.C. P.S. Saidnangli, District J.P. Nagar placed below at 'A'.

In the aforesaid letter Sri Shankar Prasad Srivastava stated that the aforesaid case is pending before his Court in which all the witness have been examined but evidence of Sri Mohd. Quamar the then Judicial Magistrate, J.P. Nagar, who had recorded the statement of complainant under section 164 Cr.P.C., has not been done. Sri Shankar Prasad Srivastava has requested this Court to direct Sri Mohd. Quamar, Civil Judge, (Jr. Div.), Muzaffarnagar to appear before his Court for adducing his evidence on 21,10.2013.

In this connection it may be submitted that under the provisions contained in appendix-E of General Rules (Criminal), the summons in criminal cases may be served upon the Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Civil Judge (Sr. Div.) through the District Judge. In the instant case Sri Mohd. Quamar is posted as Civil Judge, (Jr. Div.), Muzaffarnagar and as such the summons may be served upon him through his District Judge.

If approved by the Registrar (Budget) the District Judge, J.P. Nagar may be informed that according to Appendix-E of General Rules (Criminal), the summons in criminal cases may be served upon the Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Civil Judge (Sr. Div.) through the District Judge. In the instant case Sri Mohd. Quamar is posted as Civil Judge, (Jr. Div.), Muzaffarnagar and as such the summons may be served upon him through his District Judge?
