May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A' (page 32/C), received from Km. Sonal Pandeya, Judicial Magistrate, Balrampur for grant of permission to pursue LL.M. course.

In her letter, Km. Sonal Pandey has stated that she wants to take admission in LL.M. course of Kurukshetra University through correspondence course. The course duration is two year's and it is recognized. Examinations are held on yearly basis. First academic year is 2009-2010 and all the subjects are compulsory. In the 2nd year, there is provision of specialization, details of which will be supplied further at due time. The last date of taking admission is 19.09.2009. She assured that by taking admission and appearing in examinations, her judicial work will not hamper. She has, therefore, requested the Court to grant her permission to take admission and to pursue the LL.M. degree course.

In this connection it is submitted that Km. Sonal Pandeya is a newly appointed officer. She is willing to pursue the course through correspondence and as such, there appears to be no necessity to join any classes. However, acceptance of her request is on the discretion of the Court. It is also submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O.No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flag X), subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- (2) The academic classes are held outside office hours.
- (3) No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- (4) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

Under the circumstances, if approved by Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Km. Sonal Pandeya, Judicial Magistrate, Balrampur may be accorded permission to take admission and to pursue the course of LL.M. from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana through correspondence, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
