May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A' (page 4/C), received from Sri Narendra Pal Rana, Judicial Magistrate, Aligarh for grant of permission to pursue LL.M. course from Kurukshetra University through distance learning program.

In his letter, Sri Rana has stated that he wants to complete LL.M. course from Directorate of Distance Education, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra starting in the academic year 2009-10. He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to complete the LL.M. course.

In this connection it is submitted that Sri Rana is a newly appointed officer. He is willing to pursue the course through distance learning program (correspondence) and as such, there appears to be no necessity to join any classes. However, acceptance of his request is *on the* discretion of the Court. It is also submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O.No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flag X), subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- (2) The academic classes are held outside office hours.
- (3) No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- (4) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

Under the circumstances, if approved by Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Sri Narendra Pal Rana, Judicial Magistrate, Aligarh may be accorded permission to pursue & complete the course of LL.M. from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana through distance learning program (correspondence), as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
