May kindly peruse the office note submitted by I/c Joint Registrar (M), placed below. Km. Shagun Panwar, posted as Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Rampur has prayed for permission to pursue two year's course of LL.M. degree through Distance Learning Mode from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The officer says that this study course will not adversely affect his official duties. Km. Shagun Panwar has joined U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 20.04.2009 and now wants to do LL.M. course through correspondence. Office has recommended to pursue the aforesaid course subject to the following conditions as laid down G.O. No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flagged 'X').

1. Government work should not suffer in any way.
2. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
3. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if, it is found at any time that the government servant neglects her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.


The acceptance of officer's request is within the discretion of Hon'ble Court.

'A' { In view of above facts and circumstances, if approved, the file be placed before Hon'ble the Chief Justice for kind perusal and orders regarding permission to pursue LL.M. course through correspondence from Kurukshetra University, subject to the above three conditions.


