

made, shall ordinarily be treated as ^{request-80} final, but in exceptional circumstances, Government in the Administrative department may authorise a change in such declaration, provided that such a change shall not be made more than once during the service of the Government servant.

In this connection it is pertinent to mention here that prior to forwarding the application of Smt Shubhi Gupta, to the Government for obtaining the necessary orders the following points may be considered:-

As such in view of her affidavit dated 26-11-08, it is evident that permanent address of Smt Shubhi Gupta is B-1151, Indira Nagar, Lucknow after her marriage.

2- According to Hindu ^{married} tradition, the permanent address of a Hindu woman is her husband's native place.
