In her letter, Km. Shweta Dixit has stated that skales joined the judicial service on 11.05.2009 and has been posted as Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Mathura. She has applied for LL.M. correspondence course of Kurukshetra University and is willing to pursue the course from 2009-2011. She has also submitted that her judicial work will not be affected by her studies. She has, therefore, requested the Court to grant her permission to pursue the LL.M. degree course through correspondence.

In this connection it is submitted that Km. Shweta Dixit is a newly appointed officer. She is willing to pursue the course through correspondence and as such, there appears to be no necessity to join any classes. However, acceptance of her request is on the discretion of the Court. It is also submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O.No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flag X), subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- (2) The academic classes are held outside office hours.
- (3) No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- (4) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

Under the circumstances, if approved by Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Km. Shweta Dixit, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.). Mathura may be accorded permission to pursue the course of LL.M. from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana through correspondence, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
