

<u>REGISTRAR GENERAL</u>

In continuation of office note submitted by Joint Registrar (M) on 19.11.2009, submitted that Sri Rakesh Kumar Tiwari, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Bahraich (presently under going training in I.J.T.R., Lucknow) wants to do LL.M. course through correspondence from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

He has stated that the course is recognized and course duration is two years. He has further submitted that his official work will not be neglected in any way and there appears to be no necessity to join any classes. Office has not mentioned any thing objectionable in its note. Acceptance of such request is solely on the discretion of the court subject to certain condition laid down in the G. O. no. 24 /1066-Appointment(B)dated 21.08.1967 (flagged at 'X').

- Government work should not suffer in any way.
- No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- The permission can be withdrawn without notice if, it is found at any time that the government servant neglects her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

If approved, may like to place the file before Hon'ble the Chief Justice for granting permission to appear in LL.M. course through correspondence from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.
