

May Kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A', received by fax, from Sri Kamlesh Kumar Maurya, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kanpur Dehat, by which he has requested for grant of permission to appear of Civil Services Examination 2010.

In his letter at flag 'A', Sri Maurya has stated that he is willing to appear in the Civil Services Examination 2010. The last date of submitting the form to the Union Public Service Commission is 01.02.2010. He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to appear in Civil Services Examination 2010.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa recently. It is desirable that he may be accorded permission to appear in preliminary examination of Civil Services Examination 2010 at present, if the Court so desires. Permission to appear in such type of written examination may be accorded, but subject to the following conditions:

- Government work should not suffer in any way. (1)
- No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and (2)transfer.
- The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that (3)the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pankaj Mithal, Administrative Judge, Kanpur Dehat Judgeship, permission be accorded to Sri Kamlesh Kumar Maurya, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kanpur Dehat to appear in the preliminary examination of Civil Services Examination 2010, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
