May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'M', received from Sri Vishnu Pratap Singh, Judicial Magistrate, Meerut, by which he has submitted his explanation about non-submission of property statement due at the time of joining the judicial service, as well as submitted his required property statement.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri. Singh, who has joined the judicial service on 10.5.2009, had purchased a new Maruti Alto car for Rs. 3,26,102/- on 20.12.09 after taking bank loan of Rs. 2,90,000/- and had submitted the information about the same. The information, so furnished by the officer, was submitted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.T. Mustaffa through a detailed office note dated 08.2.2010 (flag 'II'), whereupon His Lordship has been pleased to order <sup>(flag 'D')</sup> for the office to report whether the officer has submitted statement of movable & immovable property during the course of his service as yet, besides the officer be called upon to submit details of family members dependant upon him. The details of family members of the officer was obtained from the officer through Court's letter dated 23.2.2010 and subsequently a note dated 30.3.10 (flag 'N') was submitted with the remark that as stated by the officer, he is a newly married and his wife Smt. Kiran Singh is only dependant on him. It was also indicated in the office note dated 30.3.2010 (flag 'N') that the misc. file of the officer shows that he has not submitted his

Statement of movable and immovable property, due to be submitted at the time of his joining in the judicial service. His Lordship then pleased to order to call for explanation of the officer for such lapse. The order was communicated to the officer vide Court's letter dated 20.4.2010.

Now, in compliance of the Court's letter, Sri. Singh has submitted his explanation (Flag 'M') in this regard and has stated that at the time of entering into judicial service, he had no knowledge of Hon'ble Court's Circular letter dated 13.5.2004 (issued in respect of property statement). This is just a mistake in ignorance, for which he apologise. He has also submitted his required property statement alongwith his letter of explanation.

It is further submitted that the explanation, as ordered by Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.P. Murtaga, is to be considered by His Lordship. The property statement, as submitted, is to be considered and seen by Hon'ble Administrative Judge of Mesrut Judgeship.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Duttijay Murtaga for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
