I have been doing MBA through correspondence from IGNOU since year 2001 much prior to the joining the judicial services (May 2009). All the papers of the MBA course were successfully cleared except one only, of which result was declared very late i.e. after joining the judicial services. Due to personal reasons I had decided to leave the course and I had opined to join LLM course, which after I had applied for High Court permission to do LLM course through correspondence. Accordingly, I did not appear in two successive examinations for the only remaining paper. Meanwhile my parents emphasized to complete the only remaining paper of MBA course, which was scheduled to be held in the month of June 2010. Immediately thereafter I submitted my application for seeking High Court permission to appear in the only remaining paper of MBA course. It was therefore, permission for both the courses could not be applied in continuation.

2. The only paper of MBA course for which I had to appear, required very little effort as it was the repetition of the course and needed minimum time to invest for its preparation.

3. Preparation for the last paper of MBA course without hampering the efficient disposal of judicial work was quite possible because, as said above it was a repetition only. Hence does not require much involvement for its preparation. Further, I have not started/joined the LLM correspondence course so far.

I find myself fully committed to my job and efficient disposal of my judicial work, which after only involvement in any other matter may be considered.

4. According to my view, MBA course will increase my efficiency in efficient disposal of managerial responsibilities/problems, arising in managing the available human resources. LLM course will obviously increase my professional knowledge and efficiency in disposal of judicial work as it is a higher level of professional course.
5. I Request you kindly to consider the matter accordingly in the light of the facts given as above.

- Note:-**(1) *Only for those students who are already enrolled with the Directorate during the session 2008-09 and have completed the 1st Year of B.Ed successfully.
- (2) ** Normal Admission dues for M.A. (Education)Part-I to be deposited on demand from the Directorate after finalization of the admission list of selected candidates.
- (3) **The students of courses having 2-years and 3-years duration enrolled with this Directorate for the session 2008-09 and have appeared in the examinations held in April/May 2009 but could not clear 50% papers of Part-I and Part-II examinations may also be provisionally allowed to join part-II and Part-III of the concerned courses by paying an additional fee of Rs. 500/- per deficient paper payable to the University at the time of admission subject to their clearing the remaining papers of Part-I and Part-II examinations in the permissible number of chances.**
- (4) **Additional fees such as late admission fee, late examination fee, etc., wherever applicable are required to be paid with the first instalment.**
- (5) Fee shall be charged separately for each Part of the course. For the Courses having more than one year duration, the candidates are required to submit fresh admission form & fee on promotion to next higher class every year.
- (6) In case of revision of various fees etc. during the academic session, the students will have to pay the difference in fee structure, etc.
- (7) **The Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Blind candidates belonging to Haryana State seeking admission to any 1-year/1st year of 2-Years/3-Years course(s) are entitled to full tuition fee concession. However, the full tuition fee concession as already given to the students during 2008-09 session in Part-I in various courses having 2-years/3-years course duration be continued in Part-II & Part-III of the course for 2009-10 & 2010-11 respectively. They shall pay the balance fee in two equal instalments (first at the time of admission and second as mentioned in Note**
