May kindly peruse the office note dated 8.4.2011 submitted by Deputy Registrar (M), placed below. Sri Awanish Gautam, Judicial magistrate, prayed for permission to complete M.B.A. Meerut has (correspondence). Sri Awanish Gautam posted as Judicial Magistrate, Meerut states that he had already completed/appeared in the remaining papers of the M.B.A. Correspondence course in the month of June 2010 for which he had already requested for and he is not pursuing the LL.M. correspondence course, for which he had been permitted vide court's order dated 28.11.2009 (flagged at 'C'). It is submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O. No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. Government work should not suffer in any way.
- 2. The academic classes are held outside office hours.
- 3. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- 4. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if, it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

In view of above facts and circumstances, if approved, the file be placed before Hon'ble the Chief Justice for His Lordship's kind perusal and to accord ex-post facto permission to complete M.B.A. (correspondence) from IGNOU.
