May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A', received from Miss Tarannum Khan, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Meerut, by which she has requested the Court to issue 'No-Objection Certificate'/'Identity Certificate' in her favour for obtaining Passport.

In her letter, Miss Tarannum Khan has stated that she is a judicial officer PCS (J) of 2006 batch, presently posted at Meerut as Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.). She expect that her parents will go to Haj in forth coming year so opportunity will arise of visiting the foreign country. So she needs a passport. In this regard, she has also stated ~~the~~ that :-

1. The applicant's conduct during her visit to foreign country shall not cause any embarrassment to the Government of India or the Government of Uttar Pradesh.
2. This is the first time that the applicant is applying for issue of No Objection Certificate, thereby no such request has been refused earlier.
3. The applicant has not visited any foreign country so far.
4. The applicant does not have any dependants.

She has also submitted her photographs and has requested for issuance of 'No-Objection Certificate'/'Identity Certificate' for obtaining Passport, so that she can make an application for the grant of passport at the earliest.

In this connection, it is submitted that 'No-objection Certificate' for obtaining a Passport may be issued to the officers in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'B'). It is further submitted that as per reports, placed below, no vigilance/departmental enquiry is pending against Miss Tarannum Khan. Now, as per orders of the Court, 'No-objection Certificates' are being issued to judicial officers for obtaining Passport.

A: May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rakesh Tiwari, Administrative Judge, Meerut Judgeship, the 'No Objection Certificate' at flag 'C' be issued, in favour of Miss Tarannum Khan, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Meerut, for obtaining Passport with the direction that she should take prior permission of the Court before proceeding abroad?
