## Hon'ble The Chairman

Sri Nipun Awasthi, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Azamgarh, who is presently under-going Foundation Course at IJTR, Lucknow has submitted his resignation from service on 15/07/2009 on his selection in The Delhi Judicial Services as Civil Judge (Junior Division).

The matter was processed by Admin 'A-1' Section and a report was submitted before Hon'ble The Chief Justice on 01/08/2009, upon which the following order was passed by his Lordship (at Flag. X)

"As proposed at 'A'.

A judicial officer before he is assigned judicial work has to necessarily undergo training.

If he does not serve after training due to resignation during training-period, the salary and other emoluments paid to him and the expenditure incurred on his training go waste and futile.

In order to overcome this, from the next year's appointment, will it not be advisable to incorporate a rule and insert condition in the advertisement that the resignation of an officer during training-period or within 2 years of joining shall not be accepted unless he deposits the amount received as salary and the amount spent on his training or a consolidated amount.

Matter may be placed before the appropriate Committee."

Now, it is required to be determined as to whether from the next year's appointment, will it be advisable to incorporate a rule and insert condition in the advertisement that the resignation of an officer during training period or within 2 years of joining shall be accepted after he deposits the amount received as salary and the amount spent on his training or a consolidated amount.
