May kindly peruse the office note dated 22.09.2010 submitted by Joint Registrar (M), placed below. Sri Raghvendra Mani, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Ambedkarnagar has prayed for permission to pursue LL.M. course through distant learning programme from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra The officer says that this study course will not adversely affect his official duties. Sri Raghvendra Mani, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Ambedkarnagar has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 17.8.2009 and now wants to do LL.M. course through distant learning programme for the Session 2010-2011. It is submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O. No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. Government work should not suffer in any way.
- 2. No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- 3. The permission can be withdrawn without notice if, it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

In view of above facts and circumstances, if approved, the file be placed before Hon'ble the Chief Justice for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders regarding permission to pursue LL.M. course through distant learning programme from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, subject to the above three conditions.
