May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abdul Mateen, Administrative Judge, Gorakhpur Judgeship, permission be accorded to Sri Bhartendra Singh, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gorakhpur to appear in preliminary examination of Civil Services Examination 2010, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
