May kindly see the letter dated 2.1.2016 (at flag 'A') of Smt. Lovely Jaiswal, Judicial Magistrate, Mathura by which she has submitted the reason of decreasing her salary in the financial years 2012-13 and 2013-14 in connection with submission of property statements.

Earlier Smt. Jaiswal has submitted her property statements for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 vide her letters dated 8.10.2015 (flag 'B' and 'B-1'), in which her salary for the financial years 2012-13 and 2013-14 was in decreasing order, hence a Court's letter dated 16.12.2015 (flag 'C') has been sent to the officer in this regard.

In reply of aforesaid Court's letter, Officer has submitted the aforesaid information vide her letter dated 26.2.2016 (flag 'A').

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 of the officer concerned, details of income, deductions, Savings, investment and expenditure made by her are given below:-

(1) In the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year 2011-12, Smt. Jaiswal's total Income from salary is Rs.5,60,488/- from this amount, she has paid Rs.2400/- against GIS, Rs.89,276/- against NPS, Rs.25,697/- against Income Tax, Rs.36,857/- against LIC, Rs.5,500/- against PPF. The balance of her Saving Bank Account(s) enhanced for Rs.25,831/- this financial year. As such, total deductions /Savings/investment is Rs.1,85,561/-. Thus a sum of Rs.3,74,927/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of four members in the financial years 2011-12.

(2) In the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year 2012-13, Smt. Jaiswal's total Income from salary is Rs.6,06,654/- from this amount, she has paid Rs.2400/- against GIS, Rs.30,900/- against Income Tax, Rs.1,38,654/- towards car loan, Rs.36,857/- against LIC, Rs.20,000/- against PPF and Rs.18,000/- against NSC. As such, total deductions /Savings/investment is Rs.2,46,811/-. The balance of her Saving Bank Account(s) decreased for Rs.30,120/- this financial year. Thus a sum of Rs.3,89,963/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of four members in the financial years 2012-13.

(3) In the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year 2013-14, Smt. Jaiswal's total Income from salary is Rs.4,36,342/- from this amount, she has paid Rs.1400/- against GIS, Rs.25,200/- against Income Tax, Rs.36,857/- against LIC, Rs.8,000/- against PPF, Rs.18,48,72/- towards car loan. The balance of her Saving Bank Account(s) enhanced for Rs.1,40,091/- this financial year. As such, total deductions /Savings/investment is Rs.3,96,420/-. Thus a sum of Rs.39,922/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of ^{four} ~~five~~ members in the financial years 2013-14.

(4) In the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year 2014-15, Smt. Jaiswal's total Income from salary is Rs.11,48,182/- from this amount, she has paid Rs.2400/- against GIS, Rs.1,03,000/- against Income Tax, Rs.1,67,613/- against CPF, Rs.1,84,872/- towards car loan, Rs.36,857/- against LIC, Rs.30,000/- against PPF. As such, total deductions /Savings/investment is Rs.5,24,742/-. The balance of her

Saving Bank Account(s) decreased for Rs.53,957/- this financial year. Thus a sum of Rs.6,77,397/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of four members in the financial years 2014-15.

In is pertinent to mention here that the husband of the officer Sri Indrajeet Singh is also Additional Civil Judge(Jr.Div.) whose annual salaries are Rs.7,31,691/-(in the financial year 2011-12), Rs.6,22,560/-(in the financial year 2012-13), Rs.7,86,501/- (in the financial year 2013-14) and Rs. 8,47,771/- (in the financial year 2014-15).

In this connection, it is submitted that Smt. Jaiswal has already submitted her property statement upto the financial year 2010-11 which was seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sudhir Agarwal, the then Administrative Judge, Gonda on 6.8.12 at flag 'Z' and the said statement is at flag 'M'.

The movable and immovable property statement for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 has been submitted by the officer vide her letter dated 8.10.15 (flag 'B' and 'B-1'). The property statement for the financial years 2011-12 and 2012-13 was due to be submitted in the financial year 2013-14 i.e. on or before 31.3.14 and property statement for the financial years 2013-14 and 2014-15 was due to be submitted in the financial year 2015-16 i.e. on or before 31.3.16. As such there is delay in submitting the property statement for the financial year 2011-12 and 2012-13 from the part of the officer.

May, if approved, the statements of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 of Smt. Lovely Jaiswal, Judicial Magistrate, Mathura may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Dr. Justice Devendra Kumar Arora, Administrative Judge, Mathura Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders ?
