May kindly see the letters, placed below at flag 'A', received from Smt. Shikha Rani Jaiswal, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Varanasi regarding submission of statement of movable property exceeding to value of one month's basic pay and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below:

(1) In the financial year 2011-12, income from salary is Rs.5,96,322/- and from this amount, Rs.2,000/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.91,696/- against CPF, Rs.24,015/- against Income Tax, Rs.84,000/- against Car loan, Rs.8,186/- against Premium of LIC policy, Rs.24,000/- against RD and Rs.5,000/- against NSC. The balance of her savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.15,526/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.2,54,423/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.3,41,899/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of two members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is practicing Chartered Accountant having annual income of Rs.6,38,000/-.

(2) In the financial year 2012-13, income from salary is Rs.3,80,037/- and from this amount, Rs.1,400/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.53,823/- against CPF, Rs.6,000/- against Income Tax, Rs.84,000/- against Car loan, Rs.8,186/- against Premium of LIC policy, Rs.5,000/- against NSC, Rs.12,000/- against RD and Rs.45,000/- deposited in her PPF a/c. The balance of her savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.68,252/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.2,83,661/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.96,376/-

was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is practicing Chartered Accountant having annual income of Rs.7,03,000/-.

(3) In the financial year 2013-14, income from salary is Rs.9,71,981/- and from this amount, Rs.3,600/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.93,003/- against CPF, Rs.61,531/- against Income Tax, Rs.84,000/- against Car loan, Rs.38,191/- against premium of Insurance policies, Rs.50,000/- against FDR, Rs.10,000/- against NSC and Rs.10,000/- deposited in her PPF a/c. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.3,50,325/-. The balance of her savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.65,925/- this financial year from previous year's balance. Thus, a sum of Rs.6,87,581/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is practicing Chartered Accountant having annual income of Rs.6,68,000/-.

(4) In the financial year 2014-15, income from salary is Rs.9,18,614/- and from this amount, Rs.2,400/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.84,309/- against CPF, Rs.66,050/- against Income Tax, Rs.84,000/- against Car loan, Rs.38,191/- against premium of Insurance policies, Rs.25,000/- against NSC and Rs.50,000/- deposited in her PPF a/c. The balance of her savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.29,294/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.3,79,244/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.5,39,370/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is practicing Chartered Accountant having annual income of Rs.6,45,000/-.

(5) In the financial year 2015-16, income from salary is Rs.4,47,857/- and from this amount, Rs.1,200/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.41,168/- against

CPF, Rs.10,500/- against Income Tax, Rs.7,000/- against Car loan, Rs.38,191/- against premium of Insurance policies and Rs.80,000/- deposited in her PPF a/c. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.1,41,059/-. The balance of her savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.39,780/- this financial year from previous year's balance. Thus, a sum of Rs.3,46,578/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of four members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is practicing Chartered Accountant having annual income of Rs.6,87,000/-.

(6) In the financial year 2016-17, income from salary is Rs.12,16,432/- and from this amount, Rs.3,600/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.1,17,693/- against CPF, Rs.1,24,982/- against Income Tax, Rs.38,191/- against premium of Insurance policies, Rs.50,000/- against Sukanya Samridhi accounts and Rs.50,000/- deposited in her PPF a/c. The balance of her savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.9,664/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.3,94,130/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.8,22,302/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting of four members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is practicing Chartered Accountant having annual income of Rs.6,87,000/-.

In this connection, it is also submitted that Smt. Shikha Rani Jaiswal has also submitted property statement for the financial year 2017-18 through her letter dated 26.11.2018 (at flag 'A') , but as per two years block policy, the same will be taken up for consideration alongwith the statement of 2018-19, which will be submitted by the officer in near future.

In this connection it is submitted that Smt. Shikha Rani Jaiswal has already submitted her property statement at the time of entering into judicial service & for the financial year 2010-11 (statement is at flag 'M') which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Anil Kumar, the then Administrative Judge, Mirzapur at

flag 'Z'.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial year 2011-12 & 2012-13 in its next financial year i.e., 2013-14 upto march 2014, 2013-14 & 2014-15 in its next financial year i.e., 2015-16 up to March 2015 and 2015-16 & 2016-17 in its next financial year i.e., 2017-18 up to March 2018. She has submitted the movable and immovable property statement for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17 vide her letter dated 26.11.2018 (at flag 'A'). As such, there is delay in submitting the property statements for the aforesaid financial years from the part of the officer for which she has requested to forgive her for delay in submitting the property statements in time in her letter dated 26.11.2018 (at flag 'A').

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17 alongwith letter dated 26.11.2018 (at flag 'A') of Smt. Shikha Rani Jaiswal, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Varanasi be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.Amit Sthalekar, Administrative Judge, Varanasi Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
