May kindly see the letter, placed below at **flag 'A'**, received from Sri Vinod Kumar-III, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Lakhimpur-Kheri regarding submission of statement of movable property exceeding to value of one month's basic pay and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2016-17, income from salary is Rs.20,37,553/- and from this amount, Rs.4,800/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.2,53,247/- against GPF, Rs.3,88,878/- against Income Tax, Rs.1,98,000/- against Home loan, Rs.10,114/- against premium of LIC policy, Rs.57,300/- against PLI and Rs.1,50,000/- deposited in his PPF a/c. The balance of his savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.5,38,165/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.16,00,504/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.4,37,049/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

(2) In the financial year 2017-18, income from salary is Rs.21,83,540/- and from this amount, Rs.4,800/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.3,35,427/- against GPF, Rs.4,60,260/- against Income Tax, Rs.1,98,000/- against Home loan, Rs.10,114/- against premium of LIC policy, Rs.57,300/- against PLI, Rs.10,00,000/- against FDR and Rs.3,00,000/- deposited in his PPF accounts. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.23,65,904/-. The balance of his savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.4,89,135/- this financial year from previous year's balance. Thus, a sum of Rs.3,06,771/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

In this connection it is submitted that Sri Vinod Kumar-III has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2015-16 (statement is at **flag 'M'**) which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Kheri at **flag 'Z'**.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 up to March 2019. He has submitted the movable and immovable property statement, for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 vide his letter dated 23.07.2018 (at flag 'A'). As such, there is no delay in submitting the aforesaid property statements from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 alongwith letter dated 23.07.2018 (at flag 'A') of Sri Vinod Kumar-III, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Lakhimpur-Kheri be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Kheri Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
