May kindly see the letter at flag 'A' received from Sri Sanjiv Pandey, Registrar, Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (posted on deputation), for grant of permission to sell his immovable property i.e. house-no. 1257, sector 18-C, Chandigarh.

In his letter, Sri Pandey has stated that he is a H.J.S. Officer of Uttar Pradesh, currently on deputation as Registrar, Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh. He is the owner of residential property bearing house no. 1257, sector 18-C, Chandigarh. The said residential property is a constructed house in plot measuring 500 sq. yard area. He wishes to sell above said house to M/s Gulmohar Township India Pvt. Ltd. SCO 222/223, second floor, sector 34-A, Chandigarh, through its Director Sri. Rakesh Kumar Sharma for the consideration of Rs.5.25 crore. The said purchaser is not related to him, neither his any case is pending before him nor he has ever decided any case related to him. He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to sell the house to the aforesaid purchaser.

In this connection, it is submitted that the said property has been shown by the officer in his property statements. The house was purchased by the officer in the year 2004 i.e. before joining the judicial service on 06-01-2011 (property statement is at flag 'B'). The relevant Rule-24 (1) of U.P. Government Servant conduct Rule-1956 speaks as follows:-

"No Government servant shall, except with the previous knowledge of the appropriate authority acquire or dispose of any immovable property by lease, mortgage, purchase, sale, gift or otherwise, either in his own name or in the name of any member of his family.

Provided that any such transaction conducted otherwise than through a regular & reputed dealer shall required the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sanjay Misra for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, Sri Sanjiv
