May Kindly see the letter/faxletter, placed below at flag 'A & 'A-1', received from Sri Ashwani Panwar, Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Lakhimpur Kheri by which he has requested for grant of permission to appear in Delhi Judicial Services Examination, 2014.

In his earlier letter dated 07-03-2014 (flagged 'A'), Sri Ashwini Panwar had stated that he wants to appear in the Delhi Judicial Services Examination. The scheduled date of the aforesaid examination is on 01-06-2014. He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to appear in the said examination. On receipt of his letter he was asked vide Court's letter dated 07-04-2014 (flagged 'C'), to furnish relevent papers of eligibility criteria, intimate the schedule date of preliminary/mains examination, if fixed in the mean time and submit declaration that by appearing in the aforesaid examination Judicial work will not suffer in any way.

Now, in reply, Sri Panwar, vide his fax letter dated 24-07-2013 (flag 'A-I') has informed that the eligibility criteria for appearing in the said examination is that candidate should not be more than 32 years of age on 01-01-2015, should be enrolled as an Advocate and must be citizen of India. He fulfill the entire criteria (copy enclosed of High school certificate and enrollment certificate from Bar Council)., the schedule date for preliminary examination is 01-06-2014 and he also declare that by appearing in aforesaid examination, Judicial work will not suffer in any way.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has joined the U.P. Nyayik Sewa on 20-05-2013. It is desirable that he may be accorded permission to appear in Delhi Judicial Services Examination, (Preliminary) at present, if the Court so desires. Permission to appear in such type of written examination may be accorded, but subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- (2) No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.

(3) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that government servant neglect his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sudhir Kumar Saxena, Administrative Judge, Lakhimpur Kheri Judgeship, permission be accorded to Sri Ashwani Panwar, Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Lakhimpur Kheri, to appear in Delhi Judicial Services (Preliminary) Examination, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
