May kindly see the letters, placed below at **flags 'A' & 'B'**, received from Sushri Durgesh Nandini, Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Mathura regarding submission of statement of movable property exceeding to value of one month's basic pay and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial years 2013-14 and 2014-15 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that earlier Sushri Durgesh Nandini, Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Mathura has submitted the movable property statement for the financial years 2013-14 and 2014-15 through her letter dated 02.11.2016 (at **flag 'C'**) but she has not mentioned the details of deductions of her salary i.e., CPF, GIS, amount deposited in the PPF a/c and LIC in each financial years, payment of income tax, date of purchasing of NSC, date of taking loan and Saving Bank Account's balance at the end of the financial years etc. Accordingly, a Court's letter dated 17.01.2017 (at **flag 'D'**) has been sent to the District Judge, Mathura with the request to kindly ask Sushri Durgesh Nandini to send the revised property statements for the aforesaid periods after mentioning the required informations to the Court, so that further necessary action may be taken in the matter.

The officer has fulfilled required details through her letters no. 364/I & 365/I dated 20.02.2017 (at **flags 'A' & 'B'** respectively).

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2013-14 and 2014-15 of the officer concerned, details of income, deductions, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2013-14, the income from salary is Rs.5,58,796/- and from this amount, Rs.25,761/- is deducted against

CPF, Rs.2,000/- against GIS and Rs.23,646/- against Income Tax. The balance of her savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.1,12,039/- this financial year. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.1,63,446/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.3,95,350/- was therefore available with herself to meet out the household expenditure in whole of the financial year.

(2) In the financial year 2014-15, the income from salary is Rs.7,42,811/- and from this amount, Rs.69,971/- is deducted against CPF, Rs.2,400/- against GIS, Rs.47,221/- against Income Tax, Rs.12,400/- against NSC, Rs.2,51,827/- paid against purchase of Car and Rs.12,867/- against Car loan. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.3,96,686/-. The balance of her savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.72,116/- this financial year. Thus, a sum of Rs.4,18,241/- was therefore available with herself to meet out the household expenditure in whole of the financial year.

In this connection it is submitted that Sushri Durgesh Nandini has already submitted her property statement at the time of joining in judicial service (statement is at **flag 'M'**) which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vikram Nath, the then Administrative Judge, Lucknow on 21.03.2016 at **flag 'Z'**.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial year 2013-14 & 2014-15 in its next financial year i.e., in 2015-16 up to March 2016. She has submitted the movable and immovable property statement for the financial year 2013-14 and 2014-15 firstly vide her letter dated 02.11.2016 (at **flag 'C'**). As such, there is some delay in submitting the aforesaid statements from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, the property statements for the financial years 2013-14 and 2014-15 alongwith letters no. 364/I & 365/I dated 20.02.2017 and 02.11.2016 (at flags 'A', 'B' & 'C' respectively) of Sushri Durgesh Nandini, Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Mathura be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice D. K. Arora, Administrative Judge, Mathura Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
