With utmost respect I have to state that my father Sri K.N.D. Dwivedi, I.P.S. (Retd.) who is now more than 70 years in age is a licenced holder of firearms in the detail being (1) .32 bore revolver sanctioned by the District Magistrate, Agra with attendant licence dated 11.02.1981, and (2) 30 Carbine (Rifle) sanctioned by U.P. Government with attendant licence dated 10.06.1980.

As per existing state government policy, licenced firearms holders above the age of 70 are required to get their inheritance/nominee recorded as per procedure. In his old age, my father now intends to transfer these firearms in my name and for that purpose relevant representations need to be made with the State Government/D.M., as per existing policy.

Keeping in view of the above, I humbly seek the permission of the Hon'ble Court in regard to my taking necessary steps required in meeting the provisions of law and in aiding my father in meeting provisions of law and procedure, in relation to transfer of the above firearms in my name.

It is therefore prayed that this letter seeking permission be placed before the Hon'ble Court for its favourable consideration, so that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to grant the above sought permission and oblige.


