If the verification reveals that the claim to belong to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe or Physically Handicapped category, as the case may be, is false, the services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under the provisions of the Indian Penal Code for production of false certificate.

3. The above appointment shall be subject to the provisions of the Delhi Judicial Service Rules, 1970 as amended up to date and other orders/instructions as may be applicable to the officers of the Delhi Judicial Service from time to time.

4. The inter-se seniority of the above named candidates in the Delhi Judicial Service vis-à-vis other selected candidates will remain the same as assigned to them in the merit list prepared by the Selection Committee in accordance with the provisions of the Delhi Judicial Service Rules, 1970 as amended up to date.

5. The above appointment shall be subject to outcome of CA No.1086/2013 titled "Sarv Rural Vs. Union of India", WP (C) No.764/2017 titled "Taniya Malik Vs. Registrar General of the High Court of Delhi", WP(C) No.831/2017 titled "Anshuman Dhunna Vs. Registrar General of the High Court of Delhi" and WP(C) No.832/2017 titled "Charu Dhankar Vs Registrar General of the High Court of Delhi" pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and WP(C) No.2828/2010 titled 'Surender Pal Singh Chauhan Vs. State & Aar.' pending before Delhi High Court.
