- 1. Short title, commencement and application.—(1) These Rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Temporary Government Servants (Termination

- (3) They shall apply to all persons holding a civil post in connection ... the affairs of Uttar Pradesh and who are under the rule-making control of Governor, but who do not hold a lien on any permanent post under Government of Uttar Pradesh.
- 2. Definition.—In these rules "temporary service" means officiating substantive service on a temporary post, or officiating service or permanent post under the Uttar Pradesh Government.

Termination of service.—(1) Notwithstanding anything to its contrary in any existing rules or orders on the subject, the services exis Government servant in temporary service shall be liable to termination as any time by notice in writing given either by the Government servant is In appointing authority or by the appointing authority to the Government servant.

Provided that the services of any such Government servant terminated forthwith, and on such termination the Govern-meritsershall be entitled to claim a sum equivalent to the amount of his pay allowances, if any, for the period of the notice or as the case may refor which such notice falls short of one month at the same rates at which was drawing them immediately before the termination of his services :
