May I kindly see the letters at  
flags 'A' and 'B' received from Smt  
A. K. Ajha, Munsif Magistrate, Purnea  
Smt Ajha has stated that he wants  
to appear in civil service (B. C. Limi-  
nary) examination of 1990 and  
requested that he may be accorded  
permission for the same.

In this connection, it is submitted  
that officers of this class are  
allowed to appear in any exami-  
nation subject to the following  
conditions:—

- (1) No preferential treatment  
with regard to grant of leave  
for preparation for and attendance  
at the matter of holding and  
travelling at all the places. Leave  
should however, normally be  
granted, subject to total inability  
to enable a government servant  
to appear at an academic  
examination.

2. Permission to attend lectures or appear for an examination may be withdrawn without notice if it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work.

3. The permission granted for a particular year or an academic course will not automatically hold good for subsequent years or for other courses.
