May kindly see the following order dated 07.07.2012 (Flag 'A') of Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Aligarh passed in the matter of submission of property statements of Sri Mahtab Ahmad, the then Additional District Judge, Aligarh now posted as Addl. District Judge, Allahabad, for the financial years 2008-2009 and 2009-2010, 2010-2011, 2011-2012:-

"The officer has submitted property statements for the years 2008-09,

2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12 i.e. for four financial years.

Circular letter No. 16/IV-h-16/ Admin(A) dated 13th May, 2004 regarding submission of statements relating to movable and immovable property by all the Judicial Officers, in continuation of Court's Circular letter No. 63/IVh/16/Admin. A Dated 10.12.1998 provides that the Judicial Officers be now required to submit property statement at the time of entering the service and there after at the interval of two financial years i.e. in every third financial vear.

He shall explain the delay in submitting property statements."

Above-mentioned order of Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Aligarh was communicated to the District Judge, Aligarh vide this Bench's D.O. Letter no. A-917/2012 'Conf.' dated 12.07.2012 (Flag 'B') for ensuring the compliance.

Now, Sri Mahtab Ahmad, the then Addl. District Judge, Aligarh now posted as Addl. District Judge, Allahabad, has send his explanation dated 08.08.2012 through the District Judge, Allahabad, vide endorsement no. 1875/IV Dated 13.08.2012 (Flag 'C') as directed by Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Aligarh.

If approved, the file alongwith above-mentioned explanation dated 08.08.2012 of Sri Mahtab Ahmad, as submitted by the District Judge, Allahabad may be placed before Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Aligarh for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders.
