May kindly peruse the letter dated 13-01-2005 (at Flag 'A') of Sri Ashok Kumar Yadav, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jaunpur regarding grant of permission to do LL.M. from Tilakdhari Postgraduate Degree College, Jaunpur affiliated to Purvanchal University.

In his letter, Sri Yadav has submitted that the classes for the said course are conducted in the morning from 7:00 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. and if he accords permission for doing LL.M., his study will not affect the Government work in any way.

In this connection, it is submitted that a Judicial Officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and lectures outside office hours in terms of G.O. No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21-08-1967 (at Flag 'X') subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- (b) The academic classes are held outside office hours. The Head of the Department should verify from the educational institutions concerned the hours during which classes will be held and permission should be given only in cases where these hours are clearly beyond the prescribed office hours.
- (c) No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- (d) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglect his/her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

In his letter, Sri Yadav has stated that he wants to do LL.M. from Tilakdhari Postgraduate Degree College, Jaunpur, affliated to Purvanchal University. The classes for the course are conducted in the morning from 7.00 a.m. to 09.30 a.m... He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to do the Course. He assures that if the permission is accorded to him, his study will not effect the Government work in any way.

In this connection, it is submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and lectures outside office hours in terms of G.O.No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flag X), subject to the following conditions:-

Government work should not suffer in any way. (1)

- (2)The academic classes are held outside office hours. The Head of the Department should verify from the educational institutions concerned the hours during which classes will be held and permission should be given only in cases where these hours are clearly beyond the prescribed office hours.
- (3)No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- (4) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if, it is found at any time that the government servant neglect his/her normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

In the instant case, the officer has requested to do LL.M. from the college, locally situated and the classes are in the morning, there seems to be nothing objectionable.

May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble the Chief Justice, permission be accorded to Sri Ashok Kumar Yadav, Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jaunpur to do the LL.M. course from Tilakdhari Postgraduate Degree College, Jaunpur, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?.
