(2) May kindly see the letter dated 6.3.19 (flag 'A') of Sri Awadh Bihari Singh, Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ghazipur by which he has submitted his movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18.

(2) In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deductions, Savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below:-

In the financial year 2016-17, Sri Singh's Total Income from Salary and other Sources is Rs.19,75,882/- (Rs.17,35,882/- from gross Income from Salary and Rs.2,40,000/- rented income from his house) and total deductions /Savings /investment/repayment of loan against GPF, GIS, Income Tax, PPF, LIC and repayment of Housing loan & the enhancement of Saving Bank Account(s) is Rs.13,06,440/-. Thus a sum of Rs.6,69,442/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of five members in the financial years 2016-17.

In the financial year 2017-18, Sri Singh's Total Income from Salary and other Sources is Rs.21,29,601/- (Rs.16,49,601/- from gross Income from Salary and Rs.4,80,000/- rented income from his house) and total deductions /Savings /investment/repayment of loan against GPF, GIS, Income Tax, PPF, LIC and repayment of Housing loan & the enhancement of Saving Bank Account(s) is Rs.14,58,150/-. Thus a sum of Rs.6,71,451/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of five members in the financial years 2017-18.

The movable and immovable property statement for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 has been submitted by the officer vide his letter dated 6.3.19(flag 'A') which was due to be submitted in the financial year 2018-19 i.e. on or before 31.3.2019. As such there is no delay in submitting the aforesaid Property statement from the part of the officer.

It is pertinent to mention here that the son of the officer Sri Ayush Vikram Singh earned Rs.2,98,000/- from Tution and coaching and daughter Km. Nishtha Singh earned 2,96,0000/- from practice in Law p.a.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Singh has already submitted his property statement upto financial year 2015-16 which was seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vipin Sinha, Administrative Judge, Ghazipur Judgeship at flag 'Z' and the
