May kindly see the letter dated 05.02.2014 (at Flag 'A') of Sri Ram Karan II, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ambedkar Nagar duly forwarded by District & Sessions Judge, Ambedkar Nagar regarding grant of personal pay under voluntary family planning programme, in terms of G.O. Pa. Ka. 4601/16-11-79-9/155/79, dated 23.02.1980.

According to papers received from Sri Ram Karan-II through letter dated 05.02.2014 and papers available on his instant personal/ Misc. file details of the claim are as under:

1. His date of birth is 21.01.1962.
2. His present age is 52 years as per his declaration but presently his age is 52 years 1 month 5 days.
3. He joined the service on 01.10.1999.
4. He has only one child vide declaration at **Flag 'B'**.
5. He has not got the personal Pay under voluntary family planning programme vide declaration at **Flag 'C'**.
6. The date of birth of his only child is 15.08.1998 vide Age & Character certificate issued by Principal, St. Peter's School, Akbarpur, Ambedkar Nagar for birth proof and attested copy of certificate is at **Flag 'D'**.
7. His wife is alive and not getting Personal Pay under Voluntary Family Planning Programme vide declaration at **Flag 'B'**.
8. Neither any departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Ram Karan II, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ambedkar Nagar nor he has been punished by stoppage of increment and he has not been suspended in connection with such enquiry as reported by Section Officer (Confidential-A) section at **Flag 'E'**.

In terms of G.O. Pa.Ka. 1683/16-11-80-9/155/79 dated 26.05.1980 and G.O. Pa.Ka. 2667/16-11-80-9/155/79 dated 11.06.1980 required declaration have been furnished by Sri Ram Karan II and same are at **Flags 'B' & 'C'**.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Ram Karan II, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ambedkar Nagar has fulfilled all the conditions as laid down in the aforesaid G.O.s for sanction of personal pay under voluntary family planning programme. Therefore he is entitled to get the benefit of personal pay
