May kindly see the letters, placed below at **flag 'A'**, received from Sri Pankaj Mishra, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Bareilly regarding submission of statement of movable property exceeding to value of one month's basic pay and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 of the officer concerned, details of income, deductions, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

- (1) In the financial year 2014-15, the income from salary & arrear is Rs.12,48,266/-, maturity amount of LIC money back policy is Rs.30,000/-, SB interest is Rs.12,054/- and Income Tax refund amount is Rs.4,520/-. Thus, the total amount is Rs.12,94,840/- and from this amount, Rs.1,34,079/- aginst GPF, Rs.4,800/- against GIS, Rs.40,541/- against premium of LiC policies, Rs.1,19,843/- against Income Tax, Rs.2,94,000/- against home loan and Rs.80,000/- deposited in his PPF account. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.6,73,263/-. The balance of his savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.694/- this financial year from previous year's balance. Thus, a sum of Rs.6,22,271/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of five members in whole of the financial year.
- (2) In the financial year 2015-16, the income from salary & arrear is Rs.19,11,262/-, maturity amount of LIC money back policy is Rs.19,096/- and SB interest is Rs.19,826/-. Thus, the total amount is Rs.19,50,184/- and from this amount, Rs.2,09,400/- against GPF, Rs.4,800/- against GIS, Rs.40,541/- against premium of LIC policies, Rs.2,10,179/- against Income Tax, Rs.2,94,000/- against home loan and Rs.1,05,000/- deposited in his PPF account. The balance of his savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.3,94,920/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total

Regueting deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.12,58,840/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.6,91,344/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of five members in whole of the financial year.

In this connection it is submitted that Sri Pankaj Mishra has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2013-14 (statement is at flag 'M') which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Krishna Murari, the then Administrative Judge, Bareilly on 30.03.2015 at flag 'Z'.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial year 2014-15 & 2015-16 in its next financial year i.e., in 2016-17 up to March 2017. He has submitted the movable and immovable property statement for the financial year 2014-15 and 2015-16 vide his letter dated 01.03.2017 (at flag 'A'). As such, there is no delay in submitting the aforesaid statements from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, the property statements for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 alongwith letter dated 01.03.2017 (at flag 'A') of Sri Pankaj Mishra, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Bareilly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Yashwant Varma, Administrative Judge, Bareilly Judgeship for His
