May kindly see the representation of Sri Subhash Chand, Civil Judge (Junior Division) Rampur, forwarded by the District Judge, Rampur Vide Endt. No. 36/I dated 20-01-2004 place below at flag (A), regarding not holding his interview for U.P. Higher Judicial Recruitment-2000.

In his representation Sri Subhash Chand has stated that he had been practicing as an Advocate at District Court at Hardwar since 1990 upto 21ist May 2001. In August, 2000 he applied for U.P. Higher Judicial Service Examination-2000 and he appeared in the said examination on 25th and 26th November, 2000. He appeared in Higher Judicial Service Examination-2000, while he was practicing as an Advocate, after completing 10 years legal practice.

That on 23rd May 2001, he joined as Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rampur. When he received the information for interview of U.P. Higher Judicial Service Examination-2000, he applied to Hon'ble High Court for permission to appear in Interview through the District Judge, Rampur vide letter No. 425/I dated 16-12-2003 and Hon'ble High Court was pleased to accord permission to him to appear in the Interview of U.P. Higher Judicial Service vide letter No. 13/IV-2942/Admin.(A) dated 03-01-2004. He was called to appear for interview before the Hon'ble H.J.S. Recruitment Committee on 12-01-2004 which was later on postponed for 17-01-2004. The Hon'ble H. J. S. Recruitment Committee refused to permit him to appear for the interview on the ground of being in service at present.

He has also mentioned in his representation that the refusal of the Hon'ble H. J. S. Recruitment Committee to appear in said interview of U.P. Higher Judicial Service Examination-2000 has resulted in great injustice, injury and irreparable loss to him because of he had appeared in U.P. Higher Judicial Service Examination-2000 as an Advocate, after having completed 10 years practice and this fact was clearly mentioned in his application moved to Hon'ble High Court seeking permission to appear in the interview for U.P.H.J.S.Examination-2000.

In this connection it is submitted that as per Higher Judicial Service Rules 1953 Recruitment for H.J.S as given in Part III-Recruitment is appended below:

- 5. Sources of recruitment:- (1) Recruitment to the service shall be made to the post of Civil and Sessions Judges-
 - (i) by promotion from the members of the Uttar Pradesh Civil Service (Judicial Branch);
 - (ii) by direct recruitment after consultation with the Court.

- Persons eligible for direct recruitment under sub-(2) clause (ii) of clause (1) of this rule shall be-
 - (a) Barrister, Advocates, Vakils or Pleaders of more than 7 years' standing:

It is pertinent to mention here that at the time of interview Sri Subhash Chand was not Barrister, Advocates, Vakils or Pleaders but at the time of submission of applications forms and written examination he was not in service.

Sri Subhash Chand, Civil Judge (Junior Division) Rampur has most respectfully prayed that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to consider his representation dated 20-01-2004 sympathetically and may further pleased to pass order to hold his interview of U.P. H. J. S. Examination-2000 and mean while the Hon'ble Court may pleased to Stay the further proceeding of selection of the above said recruitment.

- That although the Hon'ble High Court was pleased to grant me permission vide letter No.13/IV-2942/Admin.(A) dated 3.1.2004 to appear in the Interview of U.P. That the refusal to hold my Interview for H.J.S. was denial of fundamental right i.e. equal opportunity for employment contained in article 16th of constitution of India. I was perfectly eligible to appear in the said examination in Nov. 2000 and the eligibility in the said examination ought to have been decided on the basis of situation prevailed in Nov. 25th and 26th 2000 and note in Jan. 2004. Moreover, I was deprived from the Interview by 'Hon'ble the H.J.S. Committee on 17.1. 2004, on the ground of present judicial service, while at the time of U.P. Higher

Judicial service Examination which was held on 25th & 26th Nov. 2000, I was an Advocate, and was fulfilling all the CACL egibility requisit for the said examination. Westerd Therefore, I most humbly submit that the said refusal by Hon'ble H.J.S. Recruitment Committee was unjust and the matter needs to be examined throughly by Hon'ble recruitment committee and by the Hon'ble Administrative Committee of the Hon'ble High Court or if necessary by the Hon'ble full Court.
