





May kindly see the applications/ letters, placed below at flag 'A' & 'A-1', received from Sri Vijay Kumar Azad, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ghazipur by which he has requested the Court for issuance of 'No-Objection Certificate' for obtaining Passport.

In his earlier letter at flag 'A', Sri Azad had stated that he wants to apply for preparation of passport for visiting abroad, for the said purpose 'No Objection Certificate' is necessary. He had therefore, requested to place the above facts before the Hon'ble Court so that Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue 'N. Objection Certificate'. On receipt of his letter, he was asked vide Court's letter dated 17.08.2011 (flag 'Z') to furnish following information for taking necessary steps for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' for applying passport, that:-

- 1. Whether there is any possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to his visit to a foreign country?
 - 2. Whether such type of request was ever refused to him?
 - 3. Whether he has visited any foreign country till now, and if yes, to furnish details thereof.

Now, in reply of Court's letter dated 17.08.2011, Sri Azad vide his letter dated 07.09.2011 (flag 'A-1') has pointwise stated that:-

- There is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of Uttar Pradesh due to his visit to a foreign country and he shall undertake such visit only after due permission of the Hon'ble Court as envisaged in Circular Orders.
- 2. Request for such "No Objection Certificate" has never been refused.
- 3. He has never visited to foreign country till now.

He, therefore, requested that the above mentioned information/ declaration may be put up before the Hon'ble Court for its perusal and necessary orders in the matter.

In this connection, it is submitted that 'No-objection Certificate' for obtaining a Passport may be issued to the officers in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'B'). It is further submitted that as per reports, placed below, no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Azad. Now, as per orders of the Court, 'No-objection Certificates' are being issued to judicial officers for obtaining Passport.
