

Request 106



May kindly see the letters placed at flags 'A' & 'A-1', received from Sri Arvind Kumar Mishra, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Gorakhpur regarding grant of permission to visit Kathmandu (Nepal) to have darshan of Lord Pashupati Nath there.

In his letters, Sri Mishra has stated that this is the last year of his posting at Distt. Gorakhpur. He along with his wife, daughter & mother want to have darshan of Lord Pashupati Nath at Kathmandu near about around the holidays of holi . He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to visit Kathmandu (Nepal) to have darshan of Lord Pashupati Nath. He has also submitted required details/declarations necessary for Nepal visit:-

- 1 There is no possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to his visit to the foreign country.
- 2 No such request was ever refused to him.
- · 3 He has not visited any foreign country till now.
 - 4 The proposed period of visit/stay is 07 days in the month of March or April 2014.

In this connection, it is submitted that in terms of G.O. No.8/12/11/ CX dated 16.3.1971, all Government servants visiting Nepal must take prior permission of the Head of the Department before visiting Nepal and they should enter Nepal territory through some custom check-post and get their luggage cleared by the custom authorities. It is also mentioned in the G.O. that permission to go to Nepal will be given only when Head of the Department is satisfied that the visit of Nepal by the Government servant is necessary and unavoidable. It is also submitted that as per the reports, placed below, no departmental/ vigilance enquiry is pending against Sri Arvind Kumar Mishra. Permission to visit foreign country is also considered by G.O no. 1/3/98/-Ka Prasko./1999 dated 14.06.1999 (copy at flag '8'). As per the G.O., the officer has furnished details of his Nepal visit.

Under the facts and circumstances mentioned above, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dilip Gupta, Administrative Judge, Gorakhpur Judgeship, Sri Arvind Kumar Mishra, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Gorakhpur may be

accorded permission to visit Nepal in the month of March or April 2014, 3. for 07 days, to have darshan of Lord Pashupati Nath there, as requested, on the conditions that he will intimate to the Court the actual date of his departure to and return from Nepal and that he will enter Nepal territory through some custom check-post and get his luggage cleared by Custom Authorities?
