Perused the office report containing details relating to purchase of Hyundai Car by Sri Chandra Shekhar Civil Judge (J.D.)

According to details as revealed from the file, the officer has taken loan to the extent of Rs. 3 lac from State Bank of India and the remaining amount i.e. Rs. 50,460/- has been met from the saving made by the officer.

The officer has put in three years of service and his carry home salary is stated to be Rs. 15475/-. The amount of loan is shown to be repayable in 60 equal instalments of Rs. 6474/-. The amount that survives out of the salary is a paltry sum of Rs. 9001/-. The information furnished on the file is in accord with the conduct Rules.

The permission is accordingly accorded the details being consistent with the Conduct Rules.

Besides according permission, I would also like to be satisfied how the officer proposes to meet the household expenses within the seemingly diminished amount of Rs. 9001/-. The question is whether the officer has other means to fall back upon to supplement his income.

The officer be called upon to furnish information. As soon as the information is received, the office would scrutinize and obtain appropriate orders from the authority that be.
