May kindly see the following order dated 11.05.2011 (Flag 'A') of Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Lucknow passed in the matter of submission of property statements of Sri Ishtiyaq Ali, the then Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow now posted in Agra Judgeship for the financial years 2004-2005, 2005-2006, 2006-2007, 2007-2008, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010.

".....C.L. No. 16/IV-h-16/Admin(A) dated 13th May 2004 (in continuation of Court's Circular letter No. 63/IV-h/16/Admin A Dated 10.12.1998) relates to submission of statements of movable and immovable property to be submitted by all the Judicial Officers. The Circular letter provides, "the Judicial Officers be now required to submit property statement at the time of entering the service and there after at the interval of two financial years i.e. in every third financial year."

The Circular letter further imperatively requires all Judicial Officers posted in judgeships to ensure strict compliance of the above Circular Letter of the Hon'ble Court in the matter. Submission of property statement is not a mere farce formality but is a predominant requirement of Government Servants Conduct Rules.

It is being noticed that the certain Judicial Officers do not adhere to the time scheme as provided in the Circular Letter and are sending their property statement in a very cursory manner.

Let him explain the delay in filing the statement. He shall submit property statements afresh strictly in accordance with the proforma appended to the Circular Letter referred to above.

Office shall forthwith place the property statements of the officer after receipt of his explanation."

Above order of Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Lucknow was communicated to the District Judge, Lucknow vide this Court D.O. Letter A-97/2011 dated 16.05.2011 (Flag 'B') for ensuring the compliance.

The District Judge, Lucknow, vide his letter no. 1207/XV-1/11 dated 20.05.2011 has informed that the concerned officer has been transferred to the Agra Judgeship, and the office has sent the above order to the District Judge, Agra to inform the officer concerned, vide this Bench's D.O. letter A-173/2011 dated 02.06.2011 and reminder D.O. letter no. A-421/2011 dated 10.08.2011 (Flag 'C' & 'D').

Now, Sri Ishtiyaq Ali, the then Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow now posted in Agra Judgeship has send his explanation dated 29.08.2011 through the District Judge, Agra, vide endorsement no. 3420/I dated 01.09.2011 (Flag 'E') as directed by Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Lucknow.

If approved, the file alongwith the above-mentioned explanation dated 29.08.2011 as submitted by Sri Ishtiyaq Ali may be placed before Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Lucknow for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders.
