May kindly see the letter dated 04.10.2013 of the District Judge, Aligarh forwarded therewith medical reimbursement claim of Sri Sunil Kumar-I, A.C.J.M., Aligarh, amounting to Rs.5,09,156.00, incurred in the treatment of Cardiac Attack at Fortis Escorts Heart Institute, New Delhi for the period from 09.05.2013 to 12.05.2013 placed at Flag 'A'.

Through the said letter the District Judge has forwarded the original claim papers and stated that Sri Sunil Kumar-I, A.C.J.M., Aligarh has submitted the medical reimbursement claim for Rs.5,93,146.00 and after the technical examination the C.M.O. Aligarh has verified the claim for Rs.5,09,156.00. The District Judge, Aligarh has requested this Court to forward the claim to the Government.

It is pertinent to mention here that according to Medical Attendance Rule-2011 notification no. 2275/V-6-11-1082-87, dated 20.09.2011 the medical reimbursement claims of U.P. Government employees for more than Rs.2,50,000.00 is to be sanctioned by the Government. According to Medical Attendance Rule-2011 the medical reimbursement claim for more than Rs.5,00,000.00 is to be sanction after recommendation from Medical and Health Department and prior approval of the Finance Department, the Administrative Department.

If approved by the Learned Registrar General the medical reimbursement claim, amounting to Rs.5,09,156.00 alongwith original bill/vouchers and other relevant papers of Sri Sunil Kumar-I, A.C.J.M., Aligarh may be sent to the Under Secretary, Appointment Sec.-4, Govt. of U.P., Lucknow for necessary action in the
