May kindly see the letter dated 02.07.2009 of Sri Tayyab Ahmad, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Meerut, regarding reimbursement of medical claim amounting to Rs.56,313=00, incurred in the accidental injury ^{of} right hip ~~side~~ of his mother Smt. Fatima Begum, from 20.09.2007 to 17.10.2007 at Jaidevi hospital & Research Center, Delhi gate, Agra placed below at **Flag 'A'**.

It may be recalled that the aforesaid medical reimbursement claim was earlier submitted by Sri Tayyab Ahmad through his letter dated April 2008 (**Flagged 'B'**) when he was posted as Additional Civil Judge (Jr.Div.), Judicial Magistrate, Hathras. The aforesaid medical reimbursement claim was scrutinized by this Court and several objections were found and as such the aforesaid medical reimbursement claim was returned to Sri ~~Umesh Chandra~~ ^{Tayyab Ahmad} through Court's letter no.11704/IV-3085/Admin-(A-1)Sec., dated 11.09.2008 (**Flagged 'C'**). Sri ~~Umesh Chandra~~ ^{Tayyab Ahmad} had re-submitted his medical reimbursement claim after removing the objections through his letter dated 30.09.2008, but some of the bills/vouchers dated 29.10.2007, 01.11.2007, 10.11.2007, 13.11.2007 08.12.2007 and 03.03.2008 were found that they are beyond the period of treatment mentioned in essentiality certificate so the claim was returned to him through Court's letter no.16405/IV-3085/Admin-(A-1)Sec., dated 18.12.2008 (at **Flag 'D'**). Sri Tayyab Ahmad has re-submitted his medical reimbursement claim through his letter dated 02.07.2009 (**Flagged 'A'**) after deducting the amount. Now ~~the~~ the medical reimbursement claim of Sri Tayyab Ahmad ~~is~~ comes to Rs.56,313=00 - Rs.2115=00 = Rs.54,198=00.

The claim has been checked and found that Sri Tayyab Ahmad has submitted an Affidavit to the effect that his mother is fully dependent upon him and she has no other sources of income (placed at **Flag 'E'**). Sri Tayyab Ahmad has submitted a letter no. M.C.A/K. A/2008-09/1603, dated 27.09.2008 of The Chief Medical Officer, Mahamaya nagar by which Sri Ahmad has obtained the Ex-post-facto permission for the aforesaid treatment of his mother (placed at **Flag F'**). Sri Ahmad has also submitted Essentiality Certificate and Calculation memo duly countersigned by Chief Medical Officer, Hathras, prescription of concerned Doctor and ~~a~~ cash memos and other relevant papers. The Chief Medical Officer, Hathras has also verified the amount for Rs.56,313=00 as medical reimbursement claim on the calculation memo as well as Essentiality Certificate.

In this connection it may be submitted that medical reimbursement claims of the U.P. Dated 09.08.2004 referred to above.

Faimida Begum at Vardhman Trauma & Laparoscopy centre Pvt. Ltd., Muzaffarnagar for the period from 01.11.2009 to 12.11.2009 placed at Flag 'A'

In the aforesaid letter Sri Tayyab Ahmad has stated that he admitted his mother on 01.11.2009 at Vardhman Trauma & Laparoscopy centre Pvt. Ltd., Muzaffarnagar and the operation of Non Cemented T.H.R. Right Side had been done on 03.11.2009. On 12.11.2009 his mother had been discharged from the hospital. He has further stated that under the provision of G.O. he is submitting reference slip of the Govt. Hospital, Meerut, ex-post-facto permission of the Divisional Medical Board, Meerut Div., Meerut and a verification letter of Additional Director Medical Health & Family Welfare, Meerut Div. Meerut He has requested this Court to reimburse the claim.

The claim has been checked by this office and found that Sri Tayyab Ahmad has submitted his medical reimbursement claim alongwith Affidavit in connection with dependency of his mother at Flag 'B', a letter no. 2726/12/ M.R.C./221/2010-2011, dated 03.07.2010 at Flag 'C' of the Additional Director Medical Health and Family Welfare, Meerut Division, Meerut by which the claim has been verified for Rs.1,53,223.00, reference slip of District Hospital, Meerut, letter no.301/D.M.B, dated 12.05.2010 at Flag 'D' of Divisional Medical Board, Meerut Div., Meerut by which Smt. Faimida Begum has granted ex-post-facto permission for the treatment taken at Vardhman Trauma & Laparoscopy centre Pvt. Ltd., Muzaffarnagar. He has also submitted Essentiality Certificate and Calculation memo duly verified by the Additional Director in which sanction-able amount is mentioned for Rs.1,53,223.00 alongwith original bill/ vouchers duly countersigned by the Dr. Mukesh Jain, MS.

In this connection it may be submitted that medical reimbursement claims of the U.P. Government employees for more than Rs.1,00,000.00 but up to Rs.2,00,000.00 can be sanctioned by the Administrative Department of the Government in accordance with the provisions contained in Govt. Order No.1209/V-6-2004-294/96, T.C., Dated 09.08.2004. The instant medical reimbursement claim of Sri Tayyab Ahmad, Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Meerut, is more than Rs.1,00,000=00 and it may be sanctioned by the Administrative Department of the Government in accordance with provisions contained in G.O. Dated 09.08.2004 referred to above.
