May kindly see the letter at flag 'A', received from Km. Afshan, Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Hawali, Saharanpur regarding grant of permission to visit Saudi Arabia for pilgrimage of HAJ.

In her letter, Km. Afshan has stated that she want to go Saudi Arabia fro HAJ pilgrimage in the year 2006 with her parents. She already possesses a Passport, issued to her before joining the service and the expenses of the trip shall be born by her parents. She has further declared that: -

- (1) There is no possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Govt. of India or the Govt. of U.P. by her visit to foreign country.
- (2) Request for issue of 'No-objection Certificate' was never refused to her.
- (3) She has never visited any foreign country earlier.

She has, therefore, requested the Court to grant her permission to visit Saudi Arabia fro HAJ pilgrimage in the year 2006.

In this connection, it is submitted that grant of permission to visit abroad is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'B'). As per reports, placed below, no vigilance / departmental enquiry is pending against Km. Afshan. Km. Afshan has joined the judicial service on 07.01.2004. Now, as she has requested to grant her permission to visit Saudi Arabia in the year 2006 with her parents, who will bear all expenses of the trip, her request may be considered favorably.
