In his letter, Sri Kushal Pal has stated that in near future, there is a possibility of him to travel abroad for which passport is required. He has enclosed four passport size photographs of himself and required 'Affidavit' (flag 'B') in connection with declarations as per G.O. and Section 6 (2) of Passport Rules. His dependents are Smt Shweta Srivastava (Wife), Master Animesh Srivastava & Master Aviral Srivastava (Sons). He has, therefore, requested for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' for obtaining passport.
