

May kindly see the letters, placed below at flags 'A' & 'A-1', received from Sri Humayun Rasheed Khan, Deputy Director, Judicial Training & Research Institute, U.P., Lucknow regarding issuance of fresh 'No Objection/Identity Certificate' for obtaining Passport.

In his letters, Sri Khan has stated that he had applied for 'No Objection Certificate' before the Hon'ble Court regarding permission for passport in May, 2011 and a 'No Objection Certificate' was issued by the Hon'ble Court on 28.08.2011 to him. But due to prolong illness of his maternal grandmother and due to some other personal reasons, he couldn't apply on time & consequently the six months period expired for which he seeks apology before the Hon'ble Court as it was inadvertent. Moreover, he had never used that 'No Objection Certificate' thus, he is now returning that certificate in original to the Hon'ble High Court. He has also enclosed four passport size photographs of himself and required 'Affidavit' (flag 'B') in connection with declarations as per G.O. and Section 6 (2) of Passport Rules. Dr. Falak Butool (Wife) & Km. Mariyam Zehra (Daughter) are the dependent family members of the officer. Therefore, he has requested for issuance of fresh 'No Objection/Identity Certificate' for obtaining passport.

In this connection, it is submitted that issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' i.e. 'Identity Certificate' on new proforma for obtaining Passport is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'C'). Earlier, as per approval dated 16.09.2011 of Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Aligarh (flagged 'X'), 'No Objection Certificate' dated 28.09.2011 was issued in his favour (office copy is at flag 'D'), but as he has requested for issuance of fresh 'Identity Certificate' due to the reason that he could not apply for passport within the allotted time, his request may be considered. It is also pertinent to mention here that the officer has returned original copy of his earlier issued 'No Objection Certificate' (flagged 'Z'). As per reports, placed below, no vigilance/departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Khan. His request is considerable, as he has submitted required details and papers in this connection.

Under the facts and circumstances, mentioned above, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vikram Nath, Administrative Judge, Lucknow, the 'Identity Certificate' at flag 'E' be issued, in duplicate, in favour of Sri Humayun Rasheed Khan, Deputy Director, Judicial Training & Research Institute, U.P.,

Lucknow, as requested, for obtaining Passport with the direction that he should take prior permission of the Court before proceeding abroad?
