J.T.R./Adhi-398/14-917 dated 18.05.2015 on the above subject, I have to say that Sri Humayun Rasheed Khan, Deputy Director, JTRI, U.P., Lucknow may kindly be asked to furnish **details of his dependent family members as on date as well as to furnish declarations as per Section 6 (2) of the Passports Act, 1967, as well as following informations/ declarations, both on an 'Affidavit':-**


- (a) that the applicant is a citizen of India;
- (b) that the applicant may not, or is not likely to, engage outside India in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of India;
- (c) that the departure of the applicant from India may not, or is not likely to, be detrimental to the security of India;
- (d) that the presence of the applicant outside India may not, or is not likely to, prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country;
- (e) that the applicant has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years;
- (f) that proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India;
- (g) that a warrant or summons for the appearance, or a warrant for the arrest, of the applicant has not been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not been made by any such court;
- (h) that the applicant has not been repatriated.
- (i) Whether there is any possibility of arising embarrassing position before Government of U.P. due to his visit to any foreign country?





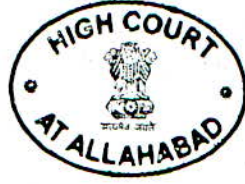
