May kindly see the applications/ letters at flag 'A' & 'A-1', received from Sri Humayun Rasheed Khan, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aligarh, by which he has requested the Court regarding permission to apply for Passport.

In his earlier letter dated 24.05.2011 (flag 'A), Sri Khan had stated that he is desirous of performing his religious obligation of pilgrimage (Haj) next year alongwith his wife and daughter. He will manage the holy tour from his own savings and the savings of his wife (School teacher). He also promise the Hon'ble Court that judicial work will not be affected in any manner in pre & post pilgrimage period. He had, therefore, requested the Hon'ble Court to kindly grant permission so that he may apply for my own passport and for the passport of his wife and daughter. On receipt of his letter, a Court's letter dated 13.07.2011 (flag 'Z') was sent informing the officer that he is not required to take permission to apply for passport for his family members and, in this case he is required to take 'No Objection Certificate' of this Court for himself only, for which he was asked to furnish following information/ declaration for taking necessary steps in the matter:-

- 1. Whether there is any possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to his visit to a foreign country?
- 2. Whether such type of request was ever refused to him?
- 3. Whether he has visited any foreign country till now, and if yes, to furnish details thereof.

Now, in reply of Court's letter dated 13.07.2011, Sri Khan vide his letter dated 22.07.2011 (flag 'A-1') has stated that:-

- 1. To the best of his ability and efforts there is no possibility of arising embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to his visit to a foreign country.
- 2. Neither any such request was made by him nor was ever refused to him by the Hon'ble Court.
- He have not had any opportunity to visit a foreign country till date.
 He has, therefore, requested the Hon'ble Court to kindly issue 'No Objection Certificate' in this regard.

In this connection, it is submitted that 'No-objection Certificate' for obtaining a Passport may be issued to the officers in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'B'). It is further submitted that as per reports, placed below, no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Khan. Now, as per

orders of the Court, 'No-objection Certificates' are being issued to judicial officers for obtaining Passport.
