May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A', received from Sri Humayun Rasheed Khan, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Iglas, Aligarh regarding grant of permission to submit the 'Ph.D.-thesis' as an Ex- student in the department of Law, A.M.U., Aligarh.

In his letter, Sri Khan has stated, that he has been appointed as Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Div.) on 15.06.2006 in Gonda Judgeship, that prior to joining of U.P. Judicial service, he was a regular student of Ph.D. In the Department of Law, A.M.U., Aligarh since 21.10.2003 and did complete the regular attendance of two years as per U.G.C. Rules (from 21.10.2003 to 21.10.2005), that his Ph.D. was in final stages when he joined U.P. Judicial service however he was not able to conclude his Ph.D. work due to paucity of time and discharge of his duties as judicial officer, that he has been transferred from Gonda to Aligarh in June 2009 and consequently he got opportunity to submit his Ph.D. thesis, that he has already received the permission of the Vice Chancellor, A.M.U., Aligarh to submit his Ph.D. thesis as an ex- student, that his Ph.D. thesis entitled "**Impact of Dispute Settlement Mechanism of WTO on Developing Countries**" is ready for submission and the only thing required is the kind permission of the Court. He has also submitted copies of order of the V.C. granting permission to submit thesis and approval of his admission in the year 2003, which may kindly be seen at flags 'Z' & 'Z-1' respectively. He has, therefore, requested that his application may be placed before the Hon'ble Court for giving permission to submit his Ph.D. thesis.

In this connection it is submitted that the officer has joined the judicial service on 15.06.2006. Prior to joining the judicial service, he was a regular student of Ph.D. and had completed the class attendance requirement. However, taking consideration of his higher academic studies, his case may be considered sympathetically for grant of permission for submitting Ph.D. thesis. Moreover, only for submitting Ph.D. thesis, there appears to be no necessity to join any classes. It is also submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O.No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flag X), subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- (2) The academic classes are held outside office hours.
- (3) No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and transfer.
- (4) The permission can be withdrawn without notice if; it is found at any time that the government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.
