Request-60

May kindly see the letter at flag 'A', received from Smt. Sandhya Srivastava, Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow regarding grant of permission to get transferred Maruti Wagon-R car in her name from her husband's name.

In the letter, Smt. Sandhya Srivastava has stated that she needs a vehicle to attend the Court daily, for which she wants to get transferred her husband's vehicle i.e. Maruti Wagon-R car no. DL-2CP-4755 in her own name. She has, therefore, requested the Court to grant her permission to get the car transferred in her name from her husband's name.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer had submitted her Property Statements, but the car has not been shown in the same, whereas it should be shown. She has also not submitted any supporting documents i.e. either a copy of 'Registration certificate' of the car or a consent letter from the side of her husband. It is further submitted that the relevant rule relating to transfer of movable property [Rule-24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct (Amendment) Rule-1998] runs as under: -

"A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority;

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

It is further submitted that as the officer has requested for grant of permission to get transferred the car in her name from her husband's name, who is also in government service as per record, she may be granted the permission, as requested, as per the rule referred to above, if the Court deemed fit and proper, under the facts and circumstances, as stated above.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.I. Murtaza
