May kindly see the letters dated 25.6.2015 and 1.2.2018 (at flag 'A' and 'A-1') of Sri Rakesh Tripathi, Additional Civil Judge(Sr.Div.), Varanasi by which he has submitted his statements of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 of the officer concerned, details of income, deductions, Savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below:-

(1) In the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year 2014-15, Sri Tripathi's Total income from Salary and other Sources is Rs.13,03,778/- (i.e. Net Income from Salary is Rs.10,09,262 + Deductions from Salary is Rs.2,34,516/- and income from House Rent is Rs.60,000/-) from this amount, he has paid Rs.4800/- against GIS, Rs.1,29,016/- against CPF, Rs.1,00,700/- against Income Tax, Rs.2,91,768/- towards installments of loan, Rs.1,00,000/- against PPF, Rs.70,047/- against LIC, Rs.72,000/- against Mutual funds and Rs.21,349/- against Bajaj Allianz. The balance of his Saving Bank Account(s) enhanced for Rs.65,904/-. As such, total deductions /Savings/investment is Rs.8,55,584/-. Thus a sum of Rs.4,48,194/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of five members in the financial year 2014-15.

(2) In the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year ~~2014-15~~ 2015-16, Sri Tripathi's Total income from Salary is Rs.12,74,804/- (i.e. Net Income from Salary is Rs.9,78,741/- + Deductions from Salary is Rs.2,24,063/- and income from House Rent is Rs.72,000/-) from this amount, he has paid Rs.4800/- against GIS, Rs.1,36,093/- against CPF, Rs.83,170/- against Income Tax, Rs.2,91,768/- towards installments of loan, Rs.1,00,000/- against PPF, Rs.1,01,147/- against LIC, Rs.72,000/- against Mutual funds and Rs.21,349/- against Bajaj Allianz. As such, total deductions /Savings/investment is Rs.8,10,327/-. The balance of his Saving Bank Account(s) decreased for Rs.13,480/-. Thus a sum of Rs.4,64,477/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of six members in the financial year 2015-16.

And as per two years block policy, the property statement for the financial year 2016-17 will be taken up for consideration alongwith property statement for the financial year 2017-18, which will be submitted by the officer in near future, be due in the financial year 2018-19.


The movable and immovable property statement for the financial years 2014-15 has been submitted by the officer vide his letter dated 25.6.2015(flag 'A') and property statement for the financial years 2015-16 has been submitted by the officer vide his letter dated 1.2.2018(flag 'A-1'). The property statements for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 was due to be submitted by the officer in the financial year 2016-17 i.e. on or

before 31.3.17. As such there is delay in submitting the property statement for the financial year 2015-16 from the part of the officer.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Tripathi has already submitted his property statement upto financial year 2013-14 which was seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Shri Narayan Shukla, the then Administrative Judge, Varanasi Judgeship on 22.9.15 with the direction to submit property statement timely in future at flag 'Z' and the said statement is at flag 'M'.

May, if approved, the statements of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 Sri Rakesh Tripathi, Additional Civil Judge(Sr.Div.), Varanasi may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice B. Amit Sthalekar, Administrative Judge, Varanasi Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders ?
