May kindly see the letter placed below at flag 'A', received from Sri Vikas Gupta, Additional District & Sessions Judge (F.T.C.), Kanpur Nagar by which he has requested for grant of permission and 'No Objection Certificate' to visit Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand alongwith his family during summer vacation from 21.06.2018 to 30.06.2018.

In his letter, Sri Gupta has stated that his real brother-in-law Mr. Vishal <sup>Mohan</sup> Garg is living at 58, Folsom Alley, Mechanicsburg, P.A. United States of America and working as Microsoft Dynamics Architect in Dentsply Sirona USA. 570 College Ave. York, PA 17401, United States of America and his annual salary is Rs. 85,00,000/- per annum. He has further stated that his parents-in-law Mr. R.P. Garg and Mrs. Gayatri Garg are celebrating Golden Jubilee of their marriage and to celebrate this occasion with all the family members, his real brother-in-law Mr. Vishal Mohan Garg wants to take all of his family members which includes his wife Mrs. Vishakha Gupta and two sons namely Kartik Gupta and Vinayak Gupta to Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand during summer vacation from 21.06.2018 to 30.06.2018. His visit to the above countries will be sponsored by him (Mr. Vishal Mohan Garg) and it will be purely personal family trip. For this trip all the travelling, fooding, lodging and other related expenses, which are approximately Rs. 2,00,000/- for ~~his~~ entire family will be borne by his brother-in-law Mr. Vishal Mohan Garg. The invitation letter and supporting letter sent by <sup>Mr. Vishal Mohan Garg and by</sup> the officer are at flags 'B' and 'C'. The incidental expenses will be borne by him (the officer) out of his salary savings (copy of statement is at flag 'D'). He has further submitted that he has a valid passport bearing no. M3366957 (copy is at flag 'E'), his wife M3820165, son Kartik M3820564 and Vinyak M3820164 which he has obtained after prior permission of this Court. He has also submitted required details/ declarations necessary for his abroad visit:-

1. He has never travelled to any foreign country, after joining Judicial Services.
2. He is applying for permission for a foreign travel for the first time and never before any such permission has been denied.
3. There will not be any position of dilemma or embarrassment to the Government of India and Government of U.P. due to his visit to the abovementioned countries.

He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to visit Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand in summer vacation alongwith his wife and two children.

In this connection, it is submitted that grant of permission to visit abroad is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'F'). As per reports, placed below, no vigilance/departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Vikas Gupta. It is also pertinent to mention here that "No Objection Certificate" is not issued by this Court for abroad visit as requested by the officer and only permission be granted for the same. Now, as the officer has requested to Hon'ble Court for grant of permission to visit Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand in summer vacation from 21.06.2018 to 30.06.2018 alongwith his wife and

two children to celebrate Golden Jubilee ceremony of his parents-in-law i.e. for purely personal reason, his request may be considered. In this connection it is also submitted that recently as per resolution of Hon'ble Administrative Committee meeting held on 17.05.2017, it has been resolved that for the purpose of grant of such permission the competent authority for the judicial officers is Hon'ble the Administrative Judge of the District concerned, for the Judicial officers posted in judgeship or on the District of any deputation post, subject to approval by Hon'ble the Chief Justice or any member of the Administrative Committee authorised by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

Under the facts and circumstances, mentioned above, if approved the file may kindly be laid before Hon'ble Justice Mr. Justice Pankaj Mittal, Administrative Judge, Kanpur Nagar and if his Lordship approves Sri Vikas Gupta, Additional District & Sessions Judge (F.T.C.), Kanpur Nagar may be granted permission to visit Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand in summer vacation from 21.06.2018 to 30.06.2018 alongwith his wife and two children to celebrate Golden Jubilee ceremony of his parents-in-law, as requested, subject to approval by Hon'ble the Chief Justice as per Administrative Committee resolution dated 17.05.2017 as mentioned above and also to the conditions that proper charge of Government records or cash, if any, or any government property with him be handed over by him before proceeding abroad?
