May kindly see the letter dated 21.07 2010, placed below at flag z received from Smt. Shikha Pathak, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ghaziabad regarding grant of permission to sell her old Maruti Zen Car.

Smt. Shikha Pathak has stated in her letter that at present she owns a Maruti Zen Car bearing registration no. UP-16-B-0250, which became too old now. She wants to sell it off. She has requested for grant of permission to sell the said Car, so that she will sell it as per rules.

In this connection it is submitted that the officer has duly mentioned the Car in her Property statement, which she owns since before joining the judicial service. However, she has not submitted any such details as to whom she is willing to sell the car, its sale price etc. The relevant Rule 24(2) of the U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules 1956, applicable in this case, is reproduced as below: -

"A Government servant who enters into any such transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority:

Provided that no Government servant shall enter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."
