May kindly see the letter dated 19.11.2013 of the District Judge, Fatehpur regarding medical reimbursement claim, amounting to Rs.1,00,978.00 of Sri Abid Shamim. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mainpuri regarding medical reimbursement claim, incurred in Polytrauma with comm. Fracture proximal humerus R with Basal fracture of his mather Smt. Naznin Fatima for the period from 10.07.2011 to 19.07.2011 at Ujala Medical Center, Indra Nagar, Lucknow placed at Flag 'A'.

It may be recalled that Sri Shamim had earlier submitted the aforesaid medical reimbursement claim through the letter dated 26.07.2013 of District Judge, Mainpuri in which it was stated that the said claim has been received in this office by the officer concerned with the covering letter of District Judge, Lucknow placed at Flag 'B' for Rs.1,00,978.00. The District Judge has further stated that as the claim is more than Rs.1,00,000.00 as such the claim has been submitted to the Head of the Department but due to following objections the said claim was returned to the District Judge Mainpuri through Court's letter dated 03.09.2013 placed at Flag 'C'.

- 2. the letter by which he has to be inform to the Head of the office according with point no.11 (b) Medical Attendance Rule- 2011.
- 3. the medical reimbursement claim is normally is required to be submitted within 3 months but the claim has submitted after a laps of 2 years for which a clarification is required.
- 4. The aforesaid claim should be preferred on the calculation memo.

Now Sri Shamim has re-submitted the claim after removing the objection Mentioned in point no.1 and 4. For the point no.2 & 3 he stated that he was unable to submit his claim to the Head of the office because he was very distressed for the illness and busy for the treatment of his mother. He has also stated that his claim period is prior to Medical Attendance Rule-2011.

The claim has been checked by the office and found that Sri Shamim has §ubmitted photocopies of bill/vouchers duly attested by the doctor. According to the point no.18 (b) of Medical Attendance Rule-2011 "Original copies of all the bills, reference letter, prescription, slips and vouchers duly verified by the treating doctor". Sri Shamim has also not submitted the emergency certificate issued by the treating doctor.

If approved by the Registrar (Budget) the aforesaid medical reimbursement claim may be returned to the District Judge, Fatehpur with the request to direct Sri Abid Shamim, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mainpuri to submit the claim alongwith emergency certificate, original bill/vouchers duly countersigned by the treating doctor, appropriate and cogent reason for delay submission of medical reimbursement claim mentioned so that necessary action may be taken.
