The aforesaid T. A bill of Sri Shukla has been received from the District Judge Rampur through his letter NO 274/IX dated 22.4.2008 (at page 'X') In the said letter the District Judge, Rampur has stated that, <sup>he said</sup> T. A bill of Sri Pawan Kumar Shukla was received on 13.3.2008 and said T. A bill was sent to the Treasury office, Rampur by the then District Judge Rampur. The Treasury office Rampur had made objection on 17.3.2008 that the said bill <sup>had</sup> become timebarred.

Now the District Judge, Rampur has requested to this court for pre-audit sanction of aforesaid T. A bill of Sri Shukla.

In this connection it is submitted that under the provision contained in Rule 74 (B) V of F.H.B Volume I Part I read with para II of the G.O NO A-1 3959/10-3/1(6)-65 dated 23-1-1986 every T. A bill should be prepared by the Government servant within one year from the date of its becoming due and thereafter it can not be entertained at all in accordance with rule referred above.

It may also be submitted that Sri Pawan Kumar Shukla has completed his journey

On 08.8.2006, whereas he has submitted his T.A bill to the District Judge, Rambar on 13.3.2008 after lapse of about one year and 7 months from the date of its becoming due of the T.A claim.

In view of the provision contained in Rule 74(B) V of F.H.B Volume II Part I and G.O No. A-1.3959/10-3/1(6) - 65 dated 23.1.1986 the aforesaid T.A bill of Sri Pawan Kumar Shukla, Addl Civil Judge (Junior Division) Rambar cannot be entertained.
